*Please bring:*

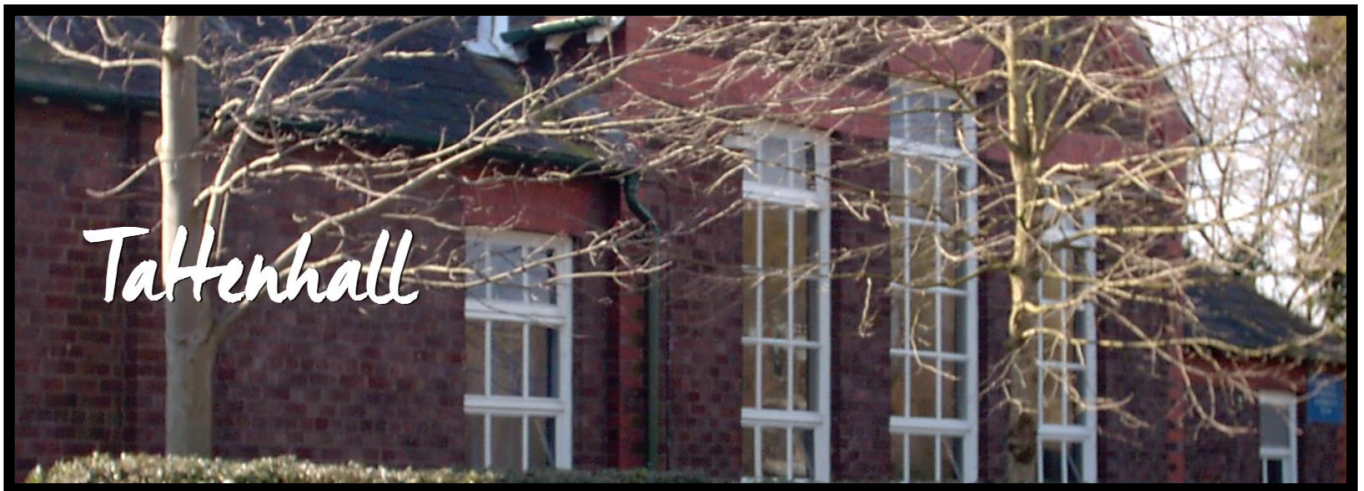
- Rucksack with packed lunch for the first day – including drink & water bottle
- Outdoor waterproof coat
- A jumper or fleece (and a spare jumper)
- Bottoms that you don't mind getting muddy. Pack enough for clean bottoms to be worn on the Tuesday and Wednesday.
- T-shirts, underwear and socks
- Trainers/outdoor shoes, (walking boots are perfect). Footwear needs to be suitable for potential wet weather and comfortable.  
Bring Wellies if you do not have walking boots/ trainers – be aware that wellies are not as comfortable
- Slippers or clean footwear for wearing indoors
- Pyjamas
- Any medication (such as inhalers) that you need to take. This must have your child's name on and be handed to Mrs Price on arrival at school.
- A wash bag and towel (don't forget toothbrush and paste)
- A carrier bag/bin bag for dirty clothes or wellies
- You may also bring: a book and teddy

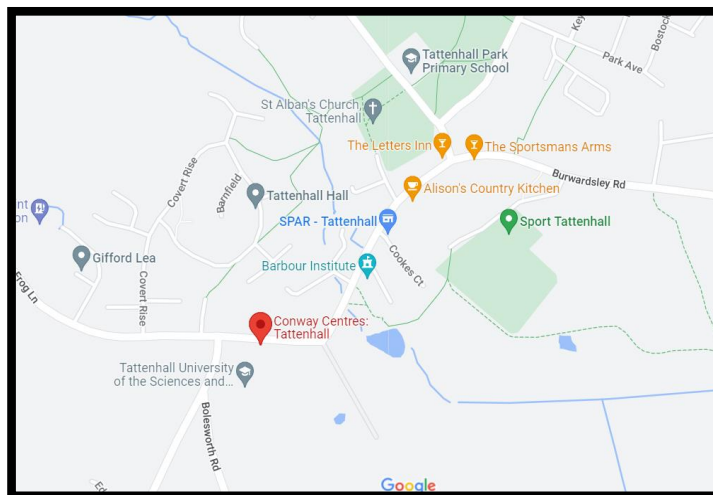
